The Exhibition & Aquarium

Uncover Spiekeroogs secrets, using our unique working models, exhibits and other installations. How did the island rise out of the sea? What does beach grass have to do with coastal protection? Find out why our historic village has remained unspoilt and what forces currently threaten the island and the Waddensee.

Up on the gallery you can meet our fascinating ocean mammals. Learn their secrets and how they have been hunted, endangered and protected.

10.000 liters of sea water in our aquarium allow you to imagine yourself underwater in the North Sea. Experience fish, crabs and animals, that would normally be at home on the tidal flats or at sea.

Wittbuelzens activities

We offer a range of guided tours and activities, both in-and outdoor. Weekly during the tourist season, more frequently during the school holidays. Have you ever asked yourself why Spiekeroog has nearly doubled in length over the last hundred years?

Where sheep once spent the winter, we now present our new laboratory and apartments for visiting scientists. Completed in September 2011, in cooperation with the University of Oldenburg, this modern complex offers many opportunities for study and research on the grounds of the Hermann-Lietz school.

This offer applies to scientists, research groups, seminars, bachelor and master students, wishing to book either short or longer stays.

Our laboratory offers:

- a central classroom, with 30 working stations
- a large preparation room
- a microscope room containing seven working stations
- a chemistry laboratory encompassing two working stations

We also offer a multimedia seminar room, for up to 40 people, including ten computer stations, with facilities for viewing films and slides and an archive containing specialist literature.

Our three apartments, with communal kitchen and day room can be booked both by single persons and groups of up to 10 persons.
